



Thanks to the **Come On In!** grant project funded by the Illinois State Library, dozens of disability-related books and videos were purchased with the needs of families, teachers, and therapists in mind. Those titles, combined with other well-reviewed materials, have been organized alphabetically by topic to make the latest research and information on disabilities easily available to Skokie Public Library users.

In addition to the titles in this bibliography, the Library also has high interest, easy reading leveled books for children in a new **Special Needs Collection**, located by the Youth Services Department entrance. The collection includes:
